> FTA Drug & Alcohol Program Support:

In support of Volpe and its customer, the U.S. Federal Transit Administration, iBiz experts design and modify databases and provide technical support for the transit community to address drug and alcohol misuse. iBiz designers and programmers improved the Drug and Alcohol Management Information System website through the development of a highly functional tool to collect and organize data. iBiz experts also provided event planning, travel-coordination, graphics, printing, and on-site direction in support of conferences designed to allow the industry leaders to meet and share their insights.

Through Volpe, iBiz provides technical advice to build the software that powers the tool, including the development and presentation of training. Additionally, iBiz experts study emerging issues such as the increase in commercial space launches and those associated consequences of greater noise and emissions.
